ANSWERS

1. Who gave Cornelius the instruction to send for Simon Peter, and why?

An angel of God. We later learnt that Peter was to tell them words whereby they would be saved (Acts 11:14)

2. Where and when did Peter have the vision of the animals in the sheet?

When Peter went up to the rooftop to pray and as he began to be hungry.

3. Why was Peter not keen to go to the house of Cornelius and associate with Gentiles? (verse 20 & verse 28)

Such association was forbidden by the law of Moses (verse 28)

4. How many other Jewish brothers accompanied Peter to Caesarea and why?

Six other Jewish brothers (verse 12) they accompanied Peter to be witnesses

5. What happened when the Jews (Peter and brothers) entered Cornelius' house?

Cornelius fell down at Peter's feet and worshipped Peter (verse 25)

6. What were Cornelius and friends expecting from Peter (verse 33; Acts 11:14)

Words whereby they would be saved.

7. What happened to the Gentiles while Peter was still speaking (verse 44-46)

The Holy Spirit fell on them and they began speaking in tongues and extolling God

8. Were the Gentiles also commanded to be baptised as the Jews on Pentecost?
(verse 48; Acts 2:38)

Yes, they were baptised in the name of Jesus exactly as the Jews were told to do on the day of Pentecost.
