

## ACTS CHAPTER TWELVE

### ANSWERS

1. How was James, the brother of John, killed? (Cf John 16:2)

King Herod killed James with the sword

2. Where and how, did Herod detain the apostle Peter?

The apostle Peter was placed in prison, being guarded by four squads of soldiers

3. How and when did the apostle Peter gain his freedom?

Peter was freed by an angel of God, the night before Peter's execution

4. Who did not believe that God would grant their petition? (Cf. John 14:13-14)

Brethren gathered in Mary's house praying for Peter's release

5. Why did the guards have to be killed when Herod could not find Peter?

Herod "examined" the sentries, which means he interrogated and found them guilty of neglect ("losing" Peter) and had them executed

6. What did the people of Tyre and Sidon do to appease Herod?

The people of Tyre & Sidon appealed to Herod's vanity by saying his speech was that of a god.

7. What happened when Herod did not give God the glory? (Cf. Isaiah 42:8)

An angel of God struck him (because he did not give God the glory) and he was eaten by worms and died

8. Who did Barnabas and Saul bring with them for their trip? (verse 25)

John, who was also called Mark.
