### ANSWERS

1. Why was the lame man laid at the temple gate? (Deuteronomy 15:10-11)

To ask alms from the people entering the temple

2. What did Peter give to the lame man instead of currency?

Healing (feet and ankles were made strong)  
in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth

3. What was the reaction of the lame man, after he was healed?

Leaping and standing and walking and praising God

4. Through whose name did Peter say, the lame man was healed?

The lame man was healed by faith in the name of Jesus

5. Who (did Peter say) killed the Author of life? (verse 15)

The leaders and Jewish people via the authorisation of the governor Pilate

6. What did the People have to do to receive forgiveness of sin? (verse 19)

They had to repent and turn back, so that their sins may be blotted out.

7. Until when would the heavens receive Jesus and what would then happen? (verse 21)

Until the time for the restoring of all things, about which He spoke by the mouth of His holy prophets long ago.

8. What is the blessing God promised “all families of the earth”? (vss. 25-26)

“...by turning every one of you from your wickedness”
