ANSWERS

1. What were the names of the husband and his wife who tried to deceive God? and what happened to them?

The husband's name was Ananias and his wife's name was Sapphira. After Peter's question and answer period, they fell down dead, and were buried.

2. What did the non-believers think of the saints? (verse 13)

None of the rest dared to join them, but the people held them in high esteem.

3. What did the high priest and the Sadducees do to the apostles? (verse 18)

They arrested the apostles and put them in the public prison

4. What did God do to get the apostles to continue preaching the gospel?

God sent an angel to free them from the prison, and commanded them to continue speaking to the people all the words of this Life.

5. How did the high priest react to the affair (of the apostles' release)?

6. What was Gamaliel's suggestion and did the council agree with it?
